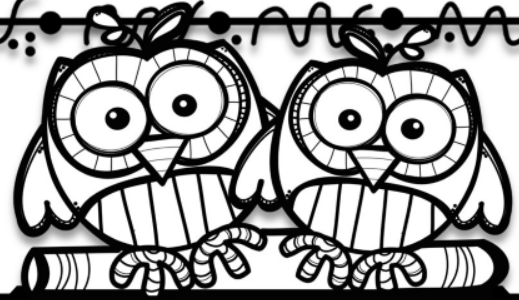

Tasty Turkey Dessert Balls



Ingredients:

- 1 pack of Oreos
- 8 oz. softened cream cheese
- 10 oz. milk chocolate
- 5 pieces of candy corn
- Candy eyes

Directions:

1. Crush the Oreo cookies in a bowl
2. Add the cream cheese to the bowl and stir
3. Scoop out a spoonful of the mixture and roll it to a ball. Continue doing this with the rest of the mixture
4. Put the balls in the freezer for 2 hours
5. Melt the chocolate
6. Remove the balls from the freezer and dip each ball in the melted chocolate
7. Place the candy corn on top to look like a tail
8. Put on the candy eyes
